Guidelines for Umpiring

When your team is scheduled to supply umpires, two are required. Both umpires will be provided with a balls-strikes-outs counter, and both should keep track in case there are any questions. If either umpire is unsure of any call, he/she may ask the opinion of the other umpire, but teams cannot “appeal” one umpire’s call to the other umpire.

Responsibilities of plate umpire

- ★ Balls and strikes. Strike zone is from the armpits to the knees, judged from where the ball crosses the front of the plate.
- ★ All plays at third base and home plate.
- ★ Monitoring the time of the game. No new inning can start after 65 minutes of play. After 6 innings, it is important to tell both captains how much time is left.

Responsibilities of base umpire

- ★ All plays at first and second bases. Listen for the sound of the ball going into the defender’s glove while watching the runner’s foot touching the safety bag.
- ★ Watch for runners leading, make sure they tag up on fly balls, and touch each base.
- ★ Be prepared to assist the plate umpire in all decisions.
